## **Description**

Use this **Scaffolding Incomplete Caution Sign** to caution staff and visitors that a certain area of scaffolding is incomplete and thus should not be used for any reason.

- Commonly found in construction sites with incomplete scaffolding.
- Features black wording and border over a bright yellow background.
- Available in a wide range of AS1319 compliant sizes and materials to suit any requirement.
- Caution signs should be placed either in advance of, next to and/or on the relevant hazard.
- Positioning and sizing of this Caution sign must comply with Australian Standard AS 1319-1994.
- Please note, Australian Standard AS 1319 states that caution sign cannot be used to warn of a hazard that is likely to be life-threatening (we recommend using a danger sign instead).
