Description

Use this **Caution Pedestrians Use Other Footpath Caution Sign** to warn pedestrians that the footpath ahead is not accessible so as to provide advance warning that they should cross the road and proceed to use the adjacent footpath.

- Commonly found in the lead up to a roadside construction site that has temporarily closed a pedestrian footpath.
- Features black wording, symbol and border over a bright yellow background.
- Available in a wide range of AS1319 compliant sizes and materials to suit any requirement.
- Caution signs should be placed either in advance of, next to and/or on the relevant hazard.
- Positioning and [sizing](#) of this Caution sign must comply with Australian Standard AS 1319-1994.
- Please note, Australian Standard AS 1319 states that caution signs cannot be used to warn of a hazard that is likely to be life-threatening (Bronson Safety recommends using a danger sign instead).
